A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE MISSION HILLS COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT REQUESTING CONSOLIDATION OF ITS BIENNIAL ELECTION WITH THE NOVEMBER 2018 CONSOLIDATED GENERAL ELECTION

WHEREAS, the Mission Hills Community Services District (the "District") is a community services district duly formed under California Government Code Section 61000 *et. seq.*, to provide community services within the District's service area, including water and sewer services as well as street sweeping; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 61008, the District is subject to the Uniform District Election Law, Part 4 (commencing with Section 10500) of Division 10 of the Elections Code; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Elections Code Sections 10500 *et. seq.*, an election is to be conducted in November 2018 to fill offices on the District Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Elections Code Section 10555, said election may be consolidated with any other election pursuant to Elections Code Sections 10400 *et. seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the District Board of Directors has determined that it should request that the Santa Barbara County Board of Supervisors consolidate the District's General Election with any other election that may be held on the same day.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Directors of the Mission Hills Community Services District as follows:

1. The Board of Supervisors of Santa Barbara County is hereby requested to consolidate the General District Election of the District to be held in November 2018, with all other elections held on the same date. This request is made pursuant to Elections Code Section 10555 and 10400, *et. seq.* The Board of Directors agrees to reimburse, upon presentation of an invoice, the County of Santa Barbara in full for services performed relating to this election.
2. The offices to be voted on are two positions on the Board of Directors for four-year terms.
3. The candidate for the elective office is to pay for the publication of a statement of qualifications pursuant to Elections Code Section 13307.


