PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The County is leasing a small area on the roof and in the gymnasium kitchen, for installation and operation of a small radio receiver and antenna and related equipment for use by Sheriff.

Reasons to support exemption findings: As set forth in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines, Section 15301 of the California Code of Regulations provides an exemption for the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that existing at the time of the lead agency's determination. The proposed action will allow the County's Sheriff Department to lease a small area on the roof and in the gymnasium kitchen for the installation and operation of a radio receiver antenna at Los Olivos School, located at 2540 Alamo Pintado Avenue, in Los Olivos, which is not likely to have any significant effect on the environment.
