**RESOLUTION OF COMMENDATION FOR CUSTODY COMMANDER SHAWN LAMMER UPON HIS RETIREMENT FROM THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE**

**WHEREAS**, Shawn Lammer will be retiring from County service on Saturday, November 29, 2025, having faithfully served the Sheriff's Office and the communities of Santa Barbara County. Shawn Lammer, having previously served as a Reserve Deputy Sheriff, Utility Worker, Custody Officer, later reclassified as Custody Deputy, Custody Deputy Special Duty, Custody Sergeant, Custody Lieutenant, and Custody Commander; and

**WHEREAS**, Shawn Lammer started his career as a Reserve Deputy Sheriff at the Goleta Police Department on January 12, 1998, and became a Correction Officer/Custody Deputy on March 22, 1999, assigned to the Main Jail located in Santa Barbara. During his almost twenty-eight years of service, he has worked in various capacities which included Jail Operations, Special Operations Response Team (SORT), Classification, Transportation, Custody Support, Risk Assessment Unit (RAU), Administrative Investigations Team (AIT), Health Services, and numerous temporary duty assignments; and

**WHEREAS**, Shawn Lammer, throughout his career, provided the employees of the Sheriff's Office with positive leadership and professionalism, allowing him to excel in the duties in his various assignments, attaining the rank of Custody Commander; and

**WHEREAS**, Shawn Lammer provided the citizens of Santa Barbara County with extraordinary professionalism and sensitive correctional law enforcement service while dedicating his life to the pursuit of justice; and

**WHEREAS**, Shawn Lammer's knowledge, skills and experience contributed greatly to the overall professionalism and the goals of the Santa Barbara County Sheriff's Office as well as the objectives of the County.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara does hereby acknowledge this Resolution of Commendation for Custody Commander Shawn Lammer upon his retirement from the Santa Barbara County Sheriff's Office.



