

Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara, State of California

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING AN AGREEMENT)
WITH THE CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF EMERGENCY) RESOLUTION NO: 24-262
SERVICES FOR THE UNSERVED/UNDERSERVED)
VICTIM ADVOCACY AND OUTREACH (UV) PROGRAM)

WHEREAS, the County of Santa Barbara District Attorney desires to undertake a certain project designated as the Unserved/Underserved Victim Advocacy and Outreach (UV) Program, to be funded in part from funds made available through the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES); and

WHEREAS, the District Attorney anticipates being awarded grant funding from Cal OES for the UV Program, subject to Board approval, in the amount of \$196,906, for the grant period of January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the District Attorney is authorized to apply for and sign on behalf of the County of Santa Barbara the Grant Subaward Signature Authorization and the Certification of Assurance of Compliance to accept grant funds for the Unserved/Underserved Victim Advocacy and Outreach (UV) Program, for the period of January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025 in the amount of \$196,906, including any amendments to the Grant Subaward extending the term thereof through June 30, 2026, or for a supplemental grant subaward in the amount not to exceed \$50,000, with the concurrence of Risk Management, County Counsel, and Auditor-Controller; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT IT IS AGREED that any liability arising out of the County of Santa Barbara District Attorney's performance of this Grant Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency. The State of California and Cal OES disclaim responsibility of any such liability.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the applicant agrees to provide any matching funds required for said project (including any amendment thereof) under the Program and the funding terms and conditions of Cal OES, and that any cash match will be appropriated as required.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.






