Having presented to each of the boards in Santa Barbara since moving here in 2003 I feel that I have a unique understanding of the processes that govern our community and understanding of the various roles played by those who serve. I have worked for three of the larger distinguished Landscape Architecture Firms, George Girvin Assoc., Van Atta Associates and Katie O'Reilly Rogers, in my early years and served as Lead Designer on many of their projects as well as Project Manager. I have been passionate about architectural design and the natural environment since I was very young and have devoted my life and career to the profession. I relish all aspects of the process and I have a strong belief in the preservation of history. My family has a very long relationship with the region. My great-great grandparents moved to the Santa Ynez Valley in the late 19th Century as Danish immigrants and established the Ballard General Store in the early 20's. My grandfather managed the Coca Cola Bottling Plant on Ortega Street until he retired in 1963. I even have a sister who is one-quarter Chumash Indian. While my parents relocated to Northern California where I was raised my history has always felt rooted to this area and region, so I feel compelled to serve and protect it.

I am fond of all types of Architectural styles from Contemporary to Ancient Temples, but I have a special affinity for 1920's Mediterraneans.


