- B. Authorize the Director of Public Works to advertise for construction bids for the 2003/2004 Minor Bridge Deck Rehabilitation at Various Locations in the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th Supervisorial Districts in Santa Barbara County; County Project No. 864030

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendations are primarily aligned with Goal No. 1. An Efficient Government Able to Respond Effectively to the Needs of the Community.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

This project consists of the minor rehabilitation of various structures throughout Santa Barbara County. Public Works plans to rehabilitate four structures at various locations in the county with a methacrylate deck

seal. This sealant will penetrate cracks in the existing bridge decks and prevent further damage to the structure. Therefore, this sealant will help provide a longer lifespan for these structures. Public Works also plans to rehabilitate two structures by replacing the top portion of the bridge deck with a polyester concrete overlay. These structures have deteriorated past the stage of a simple crack sealing and requires a portion of the decks to be replaced. Traffic will be controlled through various methods based on the traffic patterns at each location.
