WHEREAS, Marilyn joined the Board of Trustees of the Hamburg International School where she helped establish the first library for the school, and through her membership with the German-American Women's Club she organized events to raise funds to build and operate children's playgrounds and a senior center; and

WHEREAS, since being widowed in 1975 and settling in Carpinteria, Marilyn Ulvaeus has devoted her time and energies to several local groups including Get Oil Out, the Santa Barbara Zoo Auxiliary, and Phoenix of Santa Barbara; and

WHEREAS, currently Marilyn serves on the boards of the Mental Health Association and the League of Women Voters, and she is a member of Health Care For All Santa Barbara and the National Association of the Mentally Ill; and

WHEREAS, as a long-standing member of the League of Women Voters Marilyn has served as Secretary, Membership Chair and Mental Health Committee Chair, and she currently holds the portfolio on Social Policy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors honors and commends Marilyn Ulvaeus for her tireless efforts on behalf of the League of Women Voters of Santa Barbara and her dedicated service to the community.
