Recommendation(s):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Adopt the attached Resolution and direct staff to submit the following LCP amendments to the California Coastal Commission:
 - A. Carpinteria Valley Greenhouse Program (Case Nos. 99-GP-007, 99-OA-005, and 99-RZ-009);
 - B. Toro Canyon Plan (Case Nos. 00-GP-003, 00-OA-005, and 00-RZ-002).

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendations are primarily aligned with actions required by law or routine business necessity.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

Both cases referenced above amend the County's Local Coastal Program (LCP) and require certification by the California Coastal Commission. The Carpinteria Valley Greenhouse Program is scheduled for approval at the Board of Supervisors on February 19, 2002 and the Toro Canyon Plan is scheduled for approval on February 25, 2002. Staff recommends that your Board approve the attached resolution incorporating both cases into the submittal package.
