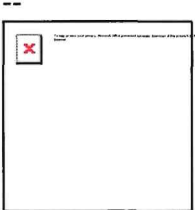

I am writing to express my strong support for the proposal by Supervisors Capps and Lee (4/21/26 Special Agenda Item 1, no. 26-00347) to (1) protect County property from incursion by federal immigration enforcement agents, (2) safeguard our elections from federal interference, and (3) block mass immigration detention centers from being set up in unincorporated County areas.

This proposal sets in motion is a sensible and measured County effort mirroring that taking place elsewhere in the State and country to assert local control against ICE lawlessness and violence. It has long been the policy of the County as well as the State to provide for a strict separation between local government and law enforcement on the one hand, and federal immigration enforcement on the other. Such a policy is essential to maintain public trust, and follows from the County's two December 2024 resolutions vowing to protect the physical safety and emotional well-being of people from all backgrounds, regardless of immigration status, and promising to take protective measures if there was an observed increase in ICE activities beginning in 2025. Since then, ICE has drastically increased the climate of fear referenced by the Board in its December 3 resolution, so that many of our residents are afraid to access County or private services, seek necessary healthcare, send their children to school, go to their places of employment, visit their houses of worship, or otherwise appear in public.

We now expect our County to assert its right to refuse to voluntarily assist the violent assault on our community by federal immigration agents, and act to protect our Constitutional rights against this assault. We've waited more than a year for the County to step forward and begin to keep the promise it made to us in December 2024. The Capps-Lee proposal is a welcome first step in this direction, and it should be adopted enthusiastically by the Board.
