Approve and execute, in duplicate, the <u>First Amendment to Landfill Gas Lease and Operating Agreement</u> between the County of Santa Barbara and Neo Tajiguas, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company for the continued operation of their methane gas collection and processing facilities at the Tajiguas Landfill.

Summary Text:

This Amendment changes and corrects the legal description that was attached to the original <u>Landfill</u> <u>Gas Lease and Operating Agreement</u> (herein the "Gas Lease") between the County of Santa Barbara ("County") and Neo Tajiguas, LLC executed March 10, 1998 for the operation of a methane gas collection and processing facility.

Background:

The County and Neo Tajiguas, LLC entered into the original Gas Lease on March 10, 1998. Neo Tajiguas, LLC subleased the facilities to MM Tajiguas Energy, LLC on June 30, 1998. Subsequent to the execution of the Gas Lease and sublease, it was noted that the legal description attached to those documents did not properly describe the lease area. Neo Tajiguas, LLC and the County agreed to amend the Gas Lease by attaching the correct legal description and adding a visual depiction showing the County's Landfill utilities within and near the Neo Tajiguas, LLC lease area.
