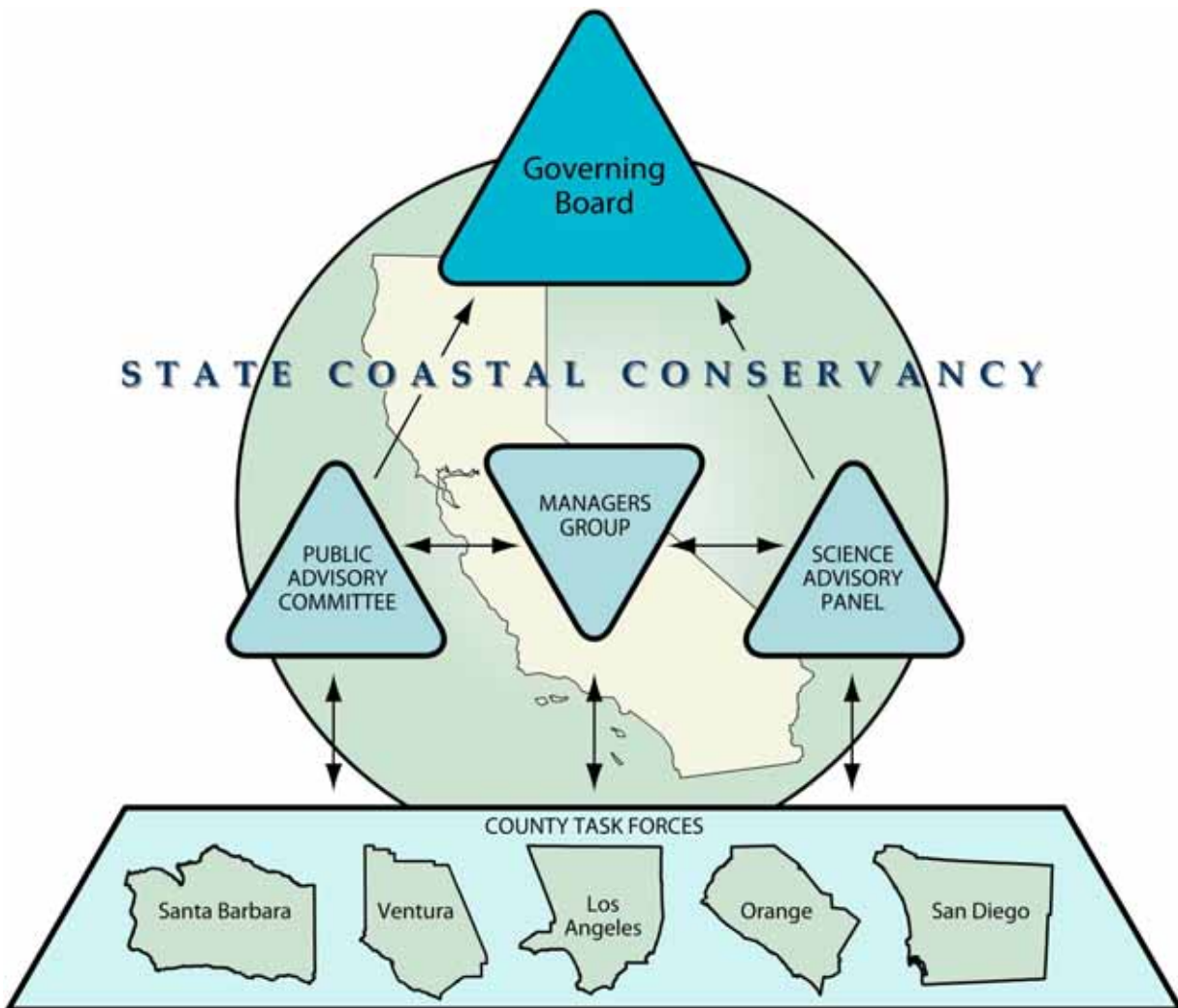


Southern California Wetlands Recovery Project
