Recommended Actions: That the Board of Supervisors adopt the resolution to:

- 1. Approve the joint application with the La Purisima Audubon Society for an Urban Stream Restoration Program grant.
- 2. Authorize the Agricultural Commissioner to execute an agreement with the California Department of Water Resources for the Urban Stream Restoration Program and the Agricultural Program Specialist to act as Project Manager for this project.

<u>Summary Text:</u> The Department of Water Resources requires a resolution from the governing body that the applicant is sponsoring the project's application for grant funding, that the applicant will address CEQA, designate a person by title who will sign a grant contract and designate a project manager. This resolution allows the Agricultural Commissioner to seek additional funding through the Proposition 84 Urban Streams Restoration grant program.

Background: The Agricultural Commissioner is conducting a tamarisk and arundo removal project on the Santa Ynez River for the conservation of habitat, water quality, and water quantity, and protection of infrastructure. This project is funded partially through the Integrated Regional Water Management Plan and Coastal Impact Assistance Program.
