PROJECT TITLE: Santa Barbara Response Network Temporary Use Permit at Isla Vista Clinic


PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The proposed action is to grant a temporary use of approximately 1,000 square feet of the first floor of the Isla Vista Clinic to the Santa Barbara Response Network to be used for the purpose of providing social support to assist the local community in recovering from the recent traumatic incidents in Isla Vista.

Cite specific CEQA Guideline Section: 15301 Existing Facilities

Reasons to support exemption findings: As set forth in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines, Section 15301 of the California Code of Regulations provides an exemption for the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that existing at the time of the lead agency's determination. The proposed action is to license the temporary use of approximately 1,000 square feet of space at the Isla Vista Clinic, located at 970 Embarcadero Del Mar, in Isla Vista, to the Santa Barbara Response Network, which is not likely to have a significant environmental impact, and is therefore exempt from further CEQA review.
