CSS Suggested Principles and Reform Options for Consideration

• Responsive and Accountable Local Government Options:

- No diversion of local tax revenues
- Change voter approval of local revenue <2/3
- Allow regional or County-wide taxes for regional services

• State Preemption of Local Control

Option:

- Require findings and supermajority vote to preempt local control

• Enhanced Protection from State Mandates

Options:

- Modernize mandates claim process
- Require mandate reimbursement

Personnel Policies and Pensions

Option:

- Allow local control of employee retirement benefits
- Focus on Outcomes in State Funding and Locally Delivered Services

Options:

- Expand block grants
- Allow for contracting and reward innovation
- Modernize State Budget

Options:

- Performance based budgeting
- Require new funding for new mandates
- Require new funding sources for statewide ballot measures that impose new obligations
- Change legislative requirements for approval of state budget and tax increases <2/3
