WHEREAS, in Santa Barbara County Adult Protective and In Home Supportive Services Social Workers help to maintain elder and dependent adults safely in their

own homes by promoting optimal health and safety; and

WHEREAS, Career Employment Specialists in the Welfare-to-Work and Workforce Investment Programs provide education, training and work-experience services to unemployed and under-employed county residents by utilizing strong case management skills and collaborative partnerships with community agencies, training providers, and local educational institutions.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara recognizes March 2013 as PROFESSIONAL SOCIAL WORK MONTH.
