Title: **Transfer Funds to Capital Assets**

Budget Action: Transfer Appropriations of \$5,200 in Sheriff's General Fund from Services and Supplies to Capital Assets for the purchase of Blue Lighting Equipment.

Justification: The Sheriff's Office receives an annual allocation of funds for Sexual Assault Felony Enforcement (SAFE) that are to be used to further training for investigating sexual assault related crimes as well as improving tools to improve our ability to solve these cases. This year, the Forensics bureau is using some of these SAFE funds to purchase Crime Lite Blue Lighting Equipment. This equipment provides an alternative light source that aids in detecting the smallest traces of forensic evidence that would be imperceptible to the human eye. This capability will help our Detectives to better be able to pursue and solve many different crimes, including those involving sexual assault. This budget revision is to transfer some of our current SAFE allocations to capital assets for this purchase.

- Justification: This budget revision establishes appropriations for a transfer from the General County Programs General Fund to the Information Technology Department, IT Services fund for reimbursement of costs incurred for consulting services provided by vendor TEKSystems relating to the ERP implementation. TEKsystems provided temporary staff labor by network technicians, infrastructure analysts and architects, and technical consultants, to provide additional support for the Workday implementation and ITD operations.

Appropriations for the cost of the work performed by this vendor were approved by the Board and budgeted for in FY 2023-24 as part of a budget revision, however, the work was not performed until early in FY 2024-25. This budget revision re-establishes appropriations to fund these costs incurred in the current fiscal year. Funding for these costs is being provided by the General County Programs General Fund Committed Countywide ERP Project fund balance where funding has been set aside for ERP implementation costs.

- Justification: This budget revision recognizes program funding and interest received in the newly established Opioid Settlement Fund, which will now be managed by the Public Health Department and places the funding in restricted Fund Balance for future distribution to various county departments and community partners based on the approved opioid abatement activities.

This budget revision establishes appropriations and transfers funds allocated by the Board of Supervisors to three departments: Behavioral Wellness Department for Recovery Residences Beds (\$200,000) and Sobering Center (\$300,000), Sheriff's Department for medication assisted treatment (\$600,600), and Community Services Department for homeless outreach (\$375,000).

On June 18th, 2024, the Board of Supervisors authorized the Public Health Department to manage the Opioid Settlement Funds. The Opioid Settlements are the result of County-initiated litigation against distributors and manufacturers of prescription opioids. The Opioid Settlement Funds must be expended on

Title: GS, Transfer appropriations for Battery Energy Storage System Controllers at Betteravia

Budget Action: Increase appropriations of \$60,000 in the General Services Utilities Fund for Capital Assets funded by a release of unreserved retained earnings.

Justification: Battery Energy Storage System Controllers at Betteravia: The solar arrays (950 kW total) at the Betteravia Campus have been energized and successfully producing renewable electricity since 8/22/2024 under conditional Permission to Operate (PTO). Due to complications while pursuing the interconnection application with the local utility (Pacific Gas and Electric), it has come to our attention that four (4) microgrid controllers must be installed on the Battery Energy Storage Systems in order to meet their requirements. These controllers are essential to ensure the campus can effectively and efficiently store excess electricity in the batteries for use at a later date. The batteries will provide critical load during power outages as well as reduce demand charges during peak pricing hours for electricity. An informal bid process has been conducted and we expect to need an additional \$60,000 to cover the cost of equipment and installation. This additional cost can be covered by unreserved fund balance within the Utilities Internal Service fund where the asset will be owned. With the controllers in place, PG&E will be able to perform their final inspection and formalize their PTO for the four microgrids.

Title: Increase of Appropriations in General County Programs for Live Oak Trails Attorney's Fees and Costs

- Budget Action: Increase appropriations of \$420,059 in General County Programs General Fund for intrafund expenditure transfer to County Counsel funded by release of \$320,059 of Committed Litigation fund balance and a \$100,000 decrease of appropriations in other charges. Establish appropriations of \$420,059 in County Counsel General Fund for services and supplies funded by an intrafund expenditure transfer from General County Programs.
- Justification: This budget revision is necessary to establish appropriations of \$420,059 in the County Counsel General Fund to pay attorney's fees and costs relating to litigation associated with the County's decision to allow hiking and biking on the Live Oak Trails on the north shore of Lake Cachuma. In this litigation filed with the Santa Barbara County Superior Court, entitled Duca et al., v. County et al., the Superior Court found in favor of the petitioners and awarded attorney's fees and costs to be paid by the County by December 18, 2024.

The total fees and costs to be paid is \$420,059 and are being funded by the General County Programs General Fund Committed Litigation fund balance. \$100,000 was appropriated in the General County Programs FY 2024-25 adopted budget for services and supplies while the remaining \$320,059 was earmarked in the Litigation fund balance for this purpose. This budget revision establishes total appropriations of \$420,059 in General County Programs to enable this funding transfer to the County Counsel department so that they may remit payment in order to satisfy the terms of the judgment.

- Budget Action: Increase appropriations of \$11,621 in the General Services Capital Outlay Fund for Capital Assets funded by an operating transfer in from the Housing/Community Development CDBG Federal fund. Increase appropriations of \$11,621 in Housing/Community Development CDBG Federal fund for Other Financing Uses funded by intergovernmental federal revenue.
- Justification: The purpose of this budget revision is to budget the \$11,621 to be transferred to the Capital Outlay fund to continue the construction of the Isla Vista Community Center improvements.
