When you See Tracks, ALWAYS Think Train!

- It takes the average freight train a mile or more to stop.
- The view near the tracks makes it impossible to judge the speed of an approaching train
- Walking or playing on or around railroad tracks is trespassing and is illegal and dangerous.

- ❖ 148 Crossing Collisions
- ❖ Of These, 93 resulted in Injury
- ❖ 128 Ended in death
