Project Title: Funding Reservations for Sierra Madre Cottages and The Residences at Depot Street

Project Description: A funding reservation is a set-aside of County funds for a specific project for a specific time period in order to allow applicants to continue efforts to secure the additional funding needed, including an allocation of Low Income Housing Tax Credits (LIHTC) to demonstrate financial feasibility. The funding reservations are for two projects; the Sierra Madre Cottages project consists of 40 affordable housing units, of which 39 will be for low-income seniors and one manager’s unit and will be developed by Peoples’ Self-Help Housing Corporation. The Residences at Depot Street project will consist of 80 affordable housing units, of which 78 will be for low-income formerly homeless and special needs households and two managers units, and will be developed by the Housing Authority of the County of Santa Barbara.


