

## County Code References

Local regulatory criteria pertaining to the Laguna County Sanitation District is found in Article III (Discharge into Laguna County Sanitation District Treatment System) of Chapter 29 (Storm Drains and Sanitary Sewers) of the County Code. The web link to the County Code is:

Two sections of the County Code are referenced in the proposed changes. They are:

Section 29-24. Penalties for violation.

- (a) A violation of this article shall be a misdemeanor punishable by fine not to exceed one hundred dollars, imprisonment not to exceed one month, or both. Each day of violation shall be a separate offense.
- (b) In addition, any person violating this article shall be liable in civil proceedings to the district for any expense, loss or damage to the district's sewer system, treatment facilities, or treatment process and for any fines imposed on the district under section 13350 of the California Water Code or pursuant to section 5650 of the California Fish and Game Code, as the result of a discharge in violation of this article.

Section 29-38. Appeals.

All decisions, interpretations or acts of the district manager shall be subject to appeal to the board of directors of the district. Any person affected by such decision may, within thirty days after such decision is rendered, file with the clerk of the board of directors of the district an appeal in writing protesting against such decision. The board of directors of the district may, after a public hearing thereon, amend, overrule or approve the decision of the district manager.
