

WHEREAS, Curt received the recognition of the Santa Maria Elks Firefighter of the Year Award (2003); and

WHEREAS, Curt still found time to restore vintage 1928, 1929, 1934 and 1966 automobiles that have starred in movies, and

WHEREAS, Curt and his wife Karen of 31 years now plan to take a few days off to enjoy traveling and spending time with their son Brent and daughter Amy and lively 2 ½ year old granddaughter,
