Recommended Actions: Authorize the Chair of the Board of Directors to:

- A) Approve the Notice of Exemption pursuant to California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines; and
- B) Accept an Exclusive Easement Deed from Mr. Joel Baker by authorizing the Clerk of the Board to execute the Certificate of Acceptance attached thereto. The easement is for flood control purposes on County Assessor's Parcel Number 137-090-068; and
- C) Execute a <u>Quitclaim Deed</u> regarding a Flood Control easement on County Assessor's Parcel Number 137-090-067.

Summary Text:

In 2005 Mr. Baker granted an easement to the Santa Barbara County Flood Control District on APN 137-090-067. Subsequent to that dedication, Mr. Baker determined the easement was inappropriately placed and requested it be moved to an adjacent parcel also owned by Mr. Baker. Flood Control management and staff agreed to the request. If executed the Quitclaim and Easement will accomplish the requested exchange.

Background:

Mr. Baker created and submitted a Parcel Map to allow for the subdivision of his parcels known as APNs 137-090-067 and -068. That Parcel Map was approved by the Board of Supervisors and then recorded on November 10, 2005, in Book 59, Pages 11 through 14, inclusive, of Maps of the County of

Santa Barbara, State of California. The Santa Barbara County Flood Control District was granted an easement via that Parcel Map. Upon further study Mr. Baker determined the location of the easement as granted was inappropriate and asked if it could be moved to an adjacent parcel he owned. After review Flood Control management and staff agreed to the revised location for the easement and directed Mr. Baker to work with Real Property to accomplish the exchange. The quitclaim and replacement easement which are the subject of this Board action will accomplish the exchange.

Narrative: There is no charge for the easement. Mr. Baker is paying for the staff time needed to accomplish the requested exchange.
