WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors finds that there is good cause to amend the classification and salary plan for unrepresented executive and unrepresented management employees;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The provisions of Resolution 16-279 and all other resolutions and their amendments, setting forth a classification and salary plan for unrepresented executive and unrepresented management employees are hereby rescinded as of the operative date of this Resolution.
2. **OPERATIVE DATE:** This Resolution shall be operative, upon the adoption by the Board of Supervisors, as of October 8, 2018.
3. The Board of Supervisors adopts the new classification and salary plan for unrepresented executive and unrepresented management employees as set forth in Appendix A to this Resolution.
