It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors:

Direct staff to communicate the Board's position on the FY 2011-12 proposed State budget and the proposed special election to the Governor and the County's State legislative delegation.

Summary Text:

On February 1, 2010, the Board of Supervisors received a report regarding the Governor's Proposed FY 2011-2012 Budget. A key component of the proposal is the realignment of public safety services to local government. This realignment of services is proposed to be funded via an extension of the "temporary" vehicle license fee and sales tax initiated in 2010. There has been significant discussion in Sacramento regarding placement of a revenue measure on the ballot. The letter attached for the Board's consideration itemizes key impacts to the County and requests that the Governor place the revenue measure on the June ballot to ensure that voters are given the opportunity to be heard on overall funding and corresponding prioritization of services.
