WHEREAS, the horrific terrorist acts of September 11, 2001 against the United States of America have forever changed the world; and

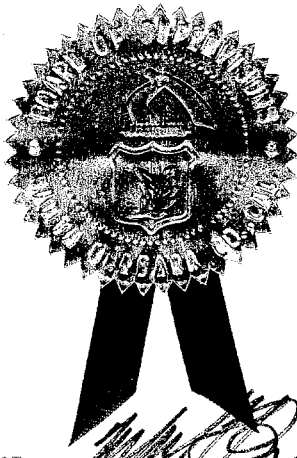
WHEREAS, the loss of so many innocent lives, including hundreds of firefighters, police and military personnel was a wound that will take several generations to heal; and
