RESOLUTION HONORING JOHN WOODWARD FOR HIS DEDICATED SERVICE AS A MEMBER OF THE COUNTY CALIFORNIA HISTORIC LANDMARKS ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, John Woodard has been a member of the County Historic Landmarks Advisory Committee since 2002 and served as Chair since 2008; and

WHEREAS, John Woodward has provided his time and expertise in the effort to preserve and protect the unique and rich history of Santa Barbara County which includes his serving on the City of Santa Barbara Historic Landmarks Commission from 1974-1982, including three years as Chairman; drafting the revised City of Santa Barbara El Pueblo Viejo Ordinance in 1977 that strengthened architectural controls in the city's historic districts and greatly enhanced legal protections for its historic landmarks; and managing both El Paseo and El Presidio State Historic Park for the Trust from 1972 to 1979; and

WHEREAS, John Woodward has served a number of boards for community organizations including the Santa Barbara Historical Museum, Pearl Chase Society, Santa Barbara Mission Archive-Library, Santa Barbara Heritage and Montecito Historical Archive and the Santa Barbara County Genealogical Society, all of which work to maintain and preserve the history of our community and residents; and

WHEREAS, John Woodward is an author, lecturer, and authority on early Santa Barbara history; writing, editing and publishing several books and articles that have preserved the early stages of our community's past for current and future generations to learn and enjoy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors honors and commends John Woodward for his service on the County History Landmarks Advisory Committee and other efforts to preserve, protect and share the history of community with all residents.
