#### **Recommended Actions:**

That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute the Statement of Final Quantities for Construction of the North Patterson Avenue Widening; County Project No. 862377; Second Supervisorial District, for work performed and materials supplied by Taylor Jane Construction, L.P. (a Tri-County Vendor), 427 Souza Drive, Nipomo, CA, 93444, in the amount of \$210,688.71; and
- b) Determine that this project was found by your Board to be exempt from the provisions of California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to State Guidelines Section 15301(c) on September 18, 2018, a Notice of Exemption was filed on that basis, and that the proposed action is within the scope of that Notice of Exemption..

#### **Summary Text:**

This item is on the agenda to approve the project as constructed and the attached Statement of Final Quantities. This Project, funded completely by the Goleta Transportation Improvement Program (GTIP), lists the Patterson Avenue Widening Project as mitigation for development in the Eastern Goleta Valley. This project widened approximately 390 feet of the westerly portion of North Patterson Avenue, beginning at Cathedral Point Lane and continuing south to join a previously-widened section at the Tree Farm residential subdivision. This project consisted of removing existing asphalt shoulder, a retaining wall, curb, gutter and sidewalk on the west side of Patterson Road. A new travel lane was also constructed and is scheduled to be opened following a preventive maintenance surface treatment this fall.

On December 4, 2018, the Board awarded the above referenced construction contract to Taylor Jane Construction, L. P. and construction work began on December 27, 2018. The Director of Public Works accepted this project as complete on March 29, 2019. This project was completed under budget.

# **Background:**

This project was constructed to provide a pedestrian thoroughfare on the west side of Patterson Avenue, between Cathedral Pointe Lane and the new Tree Farm Residential Development. This project included an additional travel lane for a continuous two-lane road on southbound Patterson Avenue, by the Goleta Transportation Improvement Program. This lane is scheduled for opening following a preventive maintenance surface treatment this fall.
