With years of historical data, AMR uses a proprietary system to analyze demand and develop a deployment strategy

AMR uses FirstWatch and FirstPass to monitor operational and clinical metrics and ensure all patients receive the highest quality of care

We utilize CODE-STAT to review and analyze our performance on all cardiac arrest patients, so we can provide feedback and improve performance

We contract with EMS Survey Team (EMSST) to conduct patient satisfaction surveys so we can monitor and benchmark our patient's experience
