RESOLUTION FOR COMMENDATION FOR STACY ROSENBERGER, JENN ADAME, NANCY SILHA, NORMA VENEGAS, AND HORTENSIA CRUZ EMPLOYEES OF THE MONTH, FEBRUARY 2018

Whereas, Public Health Department employees prioritized services to protect the health of residents during the Thomas Fire, the largest wildfire in California history; and

Whereas, Stacy Rosenberger, her co-workers, and partners including Direct Relief and the Medical Reserve Corp distributed approximately 350,000 N 95 masks free to residents in Santa Barbara County to protect them from poor air quality; and

Whereas, Jenn Adame, her co-workers, and partners including the Santa Barbara Humane Society, Equine Evac, Earl Warren, BUNS and ASAP provided safe care and shelter for animals evacuated during the fire; and

Whereas, Nancy Silha and other nurses provided daily visits providing compassionate care to people evacuated to the Red Cross shelter assisting with medications and medical issues at a challenging and stressful time; and

Whereas Norma Venegas, Hortensia Cruz, and their co-workers and in partnership with the Joint Information Center and the Air Pollution Control District, provided timely and accurate information to residents in English and Spanish so residents could be informed, prepared, safe, and healthy.

Therefore, be it hereby resolved and ordered on behalf of all Public Health Department disaster workers who provided exemplary service, we honor Stacy Rosenberger, Jenn Adame, Nancy Silha, Norma Venegas, and Hortensia Cruz as employees of the month for February 2018.
