#### **Recommended Actions:**

Approve a contract between the County and the Cities of Lompoc, Santa Barbara and Santa Maria for library services for the period of July 1, 2008- June 30, 2010 for a total cost of \$2,911,758 for Fiscal Year 2008-2009.

### **Summary Text:**

On June 13, 2008, the Board of Supervisors adopted the Fiscal Year 2008-2009 Operating Budget, which included funding to the three cities of Santa Barbara, Lompoc and Santa Maria, known as Zones 1, 2 and 3 respectively, to provide library services to County residents. The approval of the proposed contract will authorize the County to contract with the cities for library services for the period of July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2010 (although funding is for the period of July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009).

#### **Background:**

This item is on the Board's agenda in order to approve a new contract between the County and the Cities for library services and authorize the disbursement of funds to the cities for library services for fiscal year 20082-009.

In the County, library services are provided via the Cities' main libraries and various branch locations as a way to efficiently use existing facilities and prevent the creation of county-operated duplicate establishments. The zones are as follows:

■ Zone 1: Santa Barbara is the contract city. Services provided to the cities and unincorporated area located within or in close proximity to Santa Barbara, Carpinteria, Montecito, Isla Vista, Goleta, Solvang, Santa Ynez and Los Olivos.

- Zone 2: Lompoc is the contract city. Services provided to the cities and unincorporated area located within or in close proximity to Buellton, Lompoc, Vandenberg Village and Vandenberg Air Force Base.
- Zone 3: Santa Maria is the contract city. Services provided to the cities and unincorporated area located within or in close proximity to Cuyama, Guadalupe, Orcutt and Santa Maria.

The County's contribution is based on the population figures for each city as certified for January 1<sup>st</sup> of each prior fiscal year by the California State Library. Per Board action on November 6, 2007, a seven percent increase in the per capita amount has been included within the Fiscal Year 2008-2009 contract:

In addition to the County contribution, Zone 1 also receives funding for the Goleta Area from CSA #3. CSA #3 is a voter approved measure to fund library services through a benefit assessment. This amount is expected to be \$163,727 for the upcoming year and will be brought forward to the Board separately for approval.

The libraries are required to report data to the State Library for its annual report entitled "California Library Statistics", of which some of the measures are included below:
