NOW THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes County department heads to implement the furlough program, including the discretion to deviate from Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. hours of operation from December 24, 2012 through January 1, 2013 as necessary to implement the program.
