That the Board of Supervisors:
Accept the non-cash donation of material and supplies from the Pierre Claeysens Veterans Museum and Library, a non-profit organization, in the value exceeding \$10,000, and in the form of wrought iron gates, which donation does serve the public interest.

Summary:

The Board's acceptance of wrought-iron gates at the Santa Barbara Veterans Memorial Building will improve the aesthetic appeal, usability, and security of the building by allowing the front loggia archway to be closed during evening hours. The County has no obligation or caveat to the acceptance of the donation.

Background:

The Santa Barbara Veterans Memorial Building is an important structure to the military veterans in our community and the Pierre Claeysens Veterans Museum and Library organization is committed to the preservation of the memories, stories and history of those who have given the ultimate sacrifice in the defense of the United States of America. The Museum's work over the years at the Santa Barbara Veterans Memorial Building continues to support the returning Veterans.

The proposed wrought-iron gate designs have been reviewed and approved by both the Santa Barbara Veterans Council, who manage the building, and the City of Santa Barbara Historic Landmarks Commission because the Veterans Building is within the Historic Waterfront District and is a designated Structure of Merit. At its public hearing on Wednesday, September 1, 2010, the Commission was very supportive of the gates with only minor comments. They expressed gratitude to the Museum and Library for their continued support to the men and women in uniform returning to our community from service.

The non-cash donation of material and supplies are excluded from an appraisal to support the valuation amount.
