6TH ANNUAL KCOY SPRING FOOD DRIVE
FOR SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

WHEREAS, the annual KCOY Spring Food Drive is the largest single food drive in Santa Barbara County, having collected more than a quarter of a million pounds of food over the past five years; and

WHEREAS, participants with collection barrels range from grocery stores, businesses, schools, civic organizations, churches to government employees and local hospitals; and

WHEREAS, hundreds of county residents come to KCOY studios to deliver canned goods on the final day of the drive; and

WHEREAS, KCOY is dedicated to promoting events and organizations that benefit our community and runs PSA's for dozens of service groups throughout the county; and

WHEREAS, the Foodbank of Santa Barbara County depends upon community-minded individuals, organizations and businesses such as KCOY to donate food for people in need; and

WHEREAS, in collaboration with over 220 social service agencies the Foodbank provides food to more than 100,000 un-duplicated children, seniors, families and individuals in need each year in Santa Barbara County

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors honors KCOY for conducting their 2008 Spring Food Drive and further commends them for their continuing dedication to community service.
