Recommended Actions:

Receive and file report from Pacific Gas & Electric and Southern California Edison regarding installation of smart meters in Santa Barbara County and take action as appropriate.

Background:

The California Public Utilities Commission approved PG&E's smart meter plan on July 20, 2006, authorizing them to install smart meters throughout their territory and upgrade all of their approximately 5 million electric meters and 4 million gas meters over a 5-year period. On September 18, 2008, the CPUC approved Southern California Edison's plan to replace 5.3 million meters over a 4-year period. It is unknown how many smart meters are currently installed in Santa Barbara County.

On March 10, 2011 the CPUC asked PG&E to develop a smart meter op-out plan. On March 24, PG&E filed an opt-out proposal for CPUC consideration, which is currently proceeding at the Commission.

Numerous California cities and counties have voiced various public health, safety, security and privacy concerns in letters to the CPUC and many have imposed smart meter installation moratoriums considered non-binding by the Commission.
