Recommendation(s):

That the Flood Control & Water Conservation District Board of Directors execute the attached <u>Right-of-Way Contract</u> and <u>Easement Deed</u> both in relation to a portion of Santa Barbara County Assessor's parcel numbers 117-020-058 & -060, 117-160-042, 044 & -048. The easements are being granted to the State of California, Department of Water Resources for the strip of land into which the State Water Pipeline was previously installed.

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendation is aligned with Goal No. 1. An Efficient Government Able to Respond Effectively to the Needs of the Community and actions required by law or by routine business necessity.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

The State Water Pipeline was constructed/ installed in the County of Santa Barbara in 1994. The pipeline route crosses Santa Barbara County Assessor's parcel numbers 117-020-058 & -060, 117-160-042, 044 & -048 which parcels are owned by the Santa Barbara County Flood Control & Water Conservation District. Recordation of the Easements will legally and publicly acknowledge the State's right to operate and maintain the pipeline on the above referenced District owned land. The State has agreed to pay \$2,610.00 for the easement area and up to \$5,000.00 for County staff time expended in processing the Easement.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

This property is part of the Santa Maria River Levee project. The easement purchase price of \$2,610.00 will be deposited to Budget Unit 054, Fund 2570, Account 7701, Program 3002, to help offset Levee Maintenance costs. There is no facilities impact associated with this action.
