PROGRAM FOR COUNTY EMPLOYEES )  
AFFECTED BY JANUARY 2018 MUDSLIDES )

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has determined the rainstorm and subsequent mudslides during the month of January 2018 in the County and surrounding areas constitute a natural disaster, and

WHEREAS, many County employees had to incur additional expenses by using alternate transportation (e.g. train, ferry, etc.) to get to work because of said natural disaster,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, AS FOLLOWS: that employees of the County of Santa Barbara may be reimbursed up to \$35 per workday for their documented actual costs of using alternative transportation (e.g., train or ferry) to get to work between January 9, 2018 and the reopening of US 101, if they (1) were unable to use their usual mode of transportation because of road closures from the January 2018 mudslides, and (2) were not authorized by their department to work from home.




