Resolution No. 21-240

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN ALLOCATION OF FUNDING, AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING, AND THE EXECUTION OF A GRANT AGREEMENT AND ANY AMENDMENTS THERETO FROM THE 2019-2020 FUNDING YEAR OF THE CDBG MITIGATION (CDBG-MIT) RESILIENT PLANNING AND PUBLIC SERVICES PROGRAM

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara as follows:

SECTION 1:

The County Board of Supervisors has reviewed and hereby approves the projects identified below and the execution of a Standard Agreement (“Agreement”) between Santa Barbara County (“Subrecipient”) and the California Department of Housing and Community Development (“HCD”), allocating to the County the aggregate amount, not to exceed, of \$280,000 (“Grant”) for the following CDBG-MIT Planning and Public Services (MIT-PPS) project(s), pursuant to the January 2021 CDBG MIT-PPS Notice of Funding Availability.

MIT-PPS Project(s) and Amount(s)

The Subrecipient’s project(s) for the MIT-PPS program will not exceed \$280,000, identified below with project description(s) and award amount(s).

Planning Project(s)

Community Wildfire Protection Plan \$ 280,000

- After the authorized official; in this case the Santa Barbara County Fire Chief, or his designee, executes a Standard Agreement approved by the Board of Supervisors and County Counsel, this project will develop a Community Wildfire Protection Plan (CWPP) for the Santa Barbara South Coast foothill communities. The CWPP Project will be managed and implemented by the Santa Barbara County Fire Department (SBCFD). The purpose of the proposed Santa Barbara Foothills Community Wildfire Protection Plan (CWPP) is to:

- Identify potential areas for hazardous fuel reduction treatments, increase the community's understanding of living in a fire-adapted ecosystem, and improve its ability to prepare for, respond to and recover from wildland fires; and
- Recommend best practices fuel reduction treatments to protect lives and reduce structural ignitability of property, and recommend best practices to improve the fire resilience of the landscape while protecting other ecological, social, and economic values, and
- Evaluate the community transportation infrastructure, evacuation capabilities and plans, and develop recommendations for improvements

SECTION 2:

The County of Santa Barbara acknowledges compliance with all state and federal public participation requirements in the development of its application(s).

SECTION 3:

The Santa Barbara County Fire Chief, or designee, is authorized to execute and deliver all project applications and any and all related documentation required to effectuate the terms of the Agreement, and to act on the County's behalf in all matters pertaining to all such applications and documentation.

SECTION 4:

If an application is approved, the Santa Barbara County Fire Chief, or designee, is authorized to enter into, execute and deliver the grant agreement (i.e., Standard Agreement) and any and all subsequent amendments thereto, with the State of California for the purposes of the Grant.

SECTION 5:

If an application is approved, the Santa Barbara County Fire Chief, or designee, is authorized to sign and submit Funds Requests and all required reporting forms and other documentation as may be required by the State of California from time to time in connection with the Agreement for purposes of the Grant.






