Effectiveness of SHIA Services

- SHIA program utilizes Assertive Community Treatment (ACT) service delivery model
- Compared to tráditional mental health treatment models research shows ACT clients:
 - Spend significantly less time in hospitals
 - Have more time in independent living
 - Are more likely to be employed
 - Earn more income in competitive employment
 - Experience more positive social relationships
 - Express greater life satisfaction
 - Are less symptomatic.
