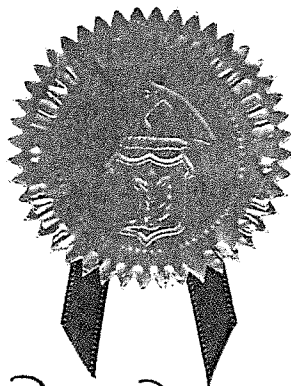

WHEREAS, the County of Santa Barbara values diversity and inclusion, and is committed to addressing gender-based disparities, supporting leadership opportunities for women, and protecting the rights of women to live free from discrimination, violence, and bias in recognizing that Women's Equality Day serves not only as a commemoration of past victories but also as a call to action to continue striving toward a more just and equitable society.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara does hereby acknowledge August 26th as Women's Equality Day, and encourages all residents to reflect on the achievements of women, acknowledge the work that remains, and commit to advancing equity and justice for all women and girls in Santa Barbara County.
