Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

Authorize increased funding for McKesson Information Systems LLC, not a local vendor, in the amount not to exceed \$160,000 for software licensing, maintenance and processing services for patient billing through May 31, 2008.

Summary Text:

There is a discrepancy in the termination date of a multi-year agreement with McKesson. The termination date according to McKesson is May 31, 2008. In a Board Letter dated June 1, 2004, Public Health indicated the term to be September 23, 2003 to September 22, 2007. Public Health would like to correct the termination date to May 31, 2008 and requests authorization for additional funding not to exceed \$160,000 for expenses through the extended termination date.

Background: The Public Health Department has used practice management software provided by McKesson for over ten years. The computer application provides registration, appointment scheduling, and patient billing processing including statements, insurance claims and electronic remittance. On June 1, 2004 Public Health requested your Board approve an agreement with McKesson for a four year period. The Board letter indicated the contract period was from September 23, 2003 to September 22, 2007. However, from McKesson's perspective, the agreement became effective June 1, 2004, the date the contract was signed by the Board, and remains in effect through May 31, 2008. The Department is requesting authorization to correct the termination date of the contract and approve funding in the amount of approximately \$160,000 for services provided by McKesson through May 31, 2008. This will

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also provide the Department additional time to evaluate the impact of retaining their existing practice management system with plans for implementation of an electronic medical record (EMR). Before May 31, 2008, the Department will return to the Board with a request to execute a new agreement with McKesson or another vendor for practice management purposes.
