PROJECT TITLE Jalama Road Bridge (51C-016) Seismic Repair

PROJECT DESCRIPTION. The project involves the seismic retrofit of Bridge #51C-016 over Ramajal Creek in northern Santa Barbara County. The bridge is on Jalama Road approximately 8.4 miles south of Lompoc. The project will be completed with minimal equipment and disturbance. The steps involved are that the existing hinge of the bridge will be locked up with splice plates and replacement deck, new steel elements will be added to the existing steel angle brace for increased capacity; anchor bolts will be added to the existing column base connection; the "leg" will be welded to the face of the existing column; and 5/8-inch-thick flange spacer plates will be added.

Reasons to support exemption findings: The project is seismic repair in the coastal zone of an existing County maintained bridge and therefore is contemplated by the CEQA exemption under section 15301. The project has been received a CDP exemption from Santa Barbara County P&D and a NEPA Categorical Exclusion has been issued under Section 6004 based on existing land uses and where the actions were originally evaluated in accordance with applicable laws, regulation and surrounding circumstances have not changed.
