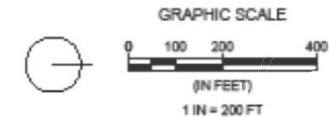

- ⚽ **19.7-acre regional park at SW corner of West Stowell Rd & South Depot St**
- ⚽ **Construction began April 2025; completion expected October 2026**
- ⚽ **Meeting long-standing recreational needs in Santa Maria**

- ⚽ **Proposition 68 (Statewide Park Development Grant) – \$6.1M**
- ⚽ **Santa Barbara County Contribution – \$1.5M**
- ⚽ **City of Santa Maria – \$1.0M+**

- ⚽ **Community Development Block Grant (CDBG FY 2025–26) – \$1.06M**

- 🏀 Site grading and mobilization complete (Q2 2025)
- ⚽ Utilities and paving through 2025

- ⚽ Final inspection and completion: October 2026
