That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute the attached Statement of Final Quantities for the 17STM1 Storm Damage Repair on Stowell Road Hydraulic Ditch Stabilization; County Project No. 862391, Fifth Supervisorial District for work performed and materials supplied by J.F. Will Company, Inc., (a local vendor), 2640 Industrial Parkway, Santa Maria, CA 93455, in the amount of \$464,199.04;
- b) Determine that the project was found by your Board to be exempt from the provisions of California Environmental Quality Act pursuant State Guidelines Section 15301(c) on May 16, 2017, a Notice of Exemption was filed on that basis, and the proposed action is within the scope of the attached Notice of Exemption.

Summary Text:

This item is on the agenda to approve the project as constructed and the attached Statement of Final Quantities. The project is an emergency repair located on Stowell Road east of U.S. 101. The work repaired damages caused by storms.

The project consisted of reshaping the existing ditch and lining the new cross section with a geosynthetic reinforced concrete. Ditch capacity was increased by widening the ditch bottom and grading the side slopes to 1:1 horizontal to vertical cross section. Project limits are from the existing headwall just east of the U.S. 101 northbound on-ramp to 2000 feet east of the headwall.

On June 20, 2017, your Board awarded the above referenced construction contract to J.F. Will Company, Inc., and construction work began on August 17, 2017. The Director of Public Works accepted this project as complete on October 12, 2017. This project was completed on time and on budget.

Narrative:

The total construction cost, including contingencies amount to \$464,199.04. The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) is anticipated to fund 88.53% of the project (\$410,955.41). The remaining 11.47% (\$53,243.63) was paid by General local funds from Dept.054, Fund 0016, Org Unit 0500, Account LI 7510.
