**Summary Text:**

This project consisted of constructing curb, gutter and sidewalks, delineating a Class II bike lane and adding angled and parallel parking, a slurry seal on Ortega Hill Road between Evans Avenue and the northbound Highway 101 On-Ramp.

This project has improved the pedestrian, vehicular and bicycle circulation for the community of Summerland.

This project was completed on June 13, 2008, under budget.



**Background:**

This project is located between the North bound US 101 on ramp and Evans Avenue on Ortega Hill Road in Summerland. This is Phase I of a multi-phased project to improve the pedestrian, vehicular and bicycle circulation by constructing curb, gutter and sidewalks, delineating a Class II bike lane and by adding parallel parking.
