Thank you for letting me submit this by email. Unfortunately and ironically I will be calling in to a meeting with Das WIlliams on the topic of wireless 9-1-1 routing at 4:30 so may not be able to make this agenda item.

My wife and I own two parcels in the Santa Rita Hills Community Services District and we support AB2455. This is a compromise solution offered by Assemblymember Williams that will allow the CSD board to continue to function until we have enough residents to fill a 5 member board.

We currently have fewer than 10 registered voters in the CSD, and when registrations are updated it may be as few as 5.

I was one of a group of parcel owners that helped organize and approval process for the CSD. The CSD is the only practical mechanism we have to organize parcel owners to build and maintain the road system. It is essential that it remain functional until the roads (and then homes) can be built and permanent voters move in and serve on the board.

Support for the CSD is nearly unanimous. The creation of the CSD was supported, in writing, by nearly every parcel owner in the District service area. The only parcel owners opposed were the Cargasacchi Family, who are now also opposed to AB2455.

Having a CSD that is able to perform it's function is essential to resolving the decades-old Lakeview access issue.
