SUBJECT: Construction of El Capitan Bike Path Extension, Project No. DG0030;
Third Supervisorial District

Recommendation(s):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Approve plans and specifications for the project;
- B. Award the construction contract in the amount of \$221,932.85 to the lowest responsible bidder, Cinary Construction Company, 4024 Lost Springs Dr., Calabasas Hills, CA 91301, subject to the provisions of the documents and certifications, as set forth in the plans and specifications applicable to the project and as required by law;
- C. Approve and authorize Chair to execute the construction contract upon return of the contractor's executed contract documents, and the review and approval of the County Counsel, Auditor-Controller and Risk Manager or their authorized representatives.

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan: The recommendations are primarily aligned with Goal No. 5.A High Quality of Life for All Residents and with Goal No. 2. A Safe and Healthy Community in Which to Live, Work, and Visit.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

This project will involve the construction of Class II bike paths on each side of Camino Real from the existing bikepath end to El Capitan State Park entrance road. This will fill in a 1,000' gap of bike path that is missing and will complete four continuous miles of dedicated bike path, completing another important link

in the coastal bike path. This route is regularly used by families camping at the state park as well as bikers traveling along Hwy 101 and includes bikers of all ages from beginner to advanced. This project will provide a safer path of travel for bicyclists traveling to and from the El Capitan State Park since they presently have to share the Camino Real road with traffic coming out the off ramp of Highway-101.

On March 16, 2005, 6 project bids were received. Cinary Construction Company, 4024 Lost Springs Dr., Calabasas Hills, CA 91301 was the low bidder for the project. Parks staff has performed an analysis of the bid and has determined that the low bid is reasonable and recommends the award of this contract.

This project is located within the Coastal Zone and has been issued a Coastal Development Permit from Planning & Development.

Mandates and Service Levels: No mandates or impact to service levels with this action.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts: Funding for this project is through a Coastal Resources Grant (AB1431) and is available in County Parks Accumulative Capital Outlay Budget 1931.
