WHEREAS, service to others is a hallmark of the American character, and central to how we meet our challenges; and

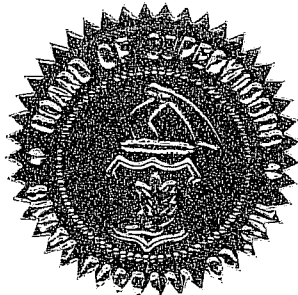
