Project Title: Isla Vista Bluff Fencing

Project Description: The project involves installation of approximately 1,600 linear feet of new or replacement fencing along the bluffs in Isla Vista. The 54-inch high fencing consists of a three-rail wooden pole fence covered with small-space coated diamond chain link on the landward side to prevent climbing and sitting.



Reasons to support exemption findings (attach additional material, if necessary):

CEQA Guideline Section 15303 Class 3 (New Construction) consists of construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures. The work consists of installation of new fencing, an accessory structure.

CEQA Guideline Section 15301 Class 1 (Existing Facilities) consists of the minor alteration of existing public structures involving negligible or no expansion of existing use. The work consists of demolishing and removal of existing fencing, an accessory structure, and does not involve the removal of any scenic resource. The exemption is not limited by factors set forth in CEQA Guideline Section 15300.2 as the repaving is a Class 1 exemption, does not have a cumulative impact, significant effect on the environment due to unusual circumstances, impact on a scenic highway(s), nor impact on historical resources. The fencing is not on a hazardous waste site.
