SUBJECT: Family Preservation and Support Program, Revised Budget, 2001-02

Recommendation(s):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Adopt a resolution approving the County of Santa Barbara Family Preservation and Support Program Revised Budget for the 2001-2002 Fiscal Year.

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan: The recommendation(s) are primarily aligned with Goal 7: Strengthen the Safety and Well-being of Children and their Families to Ensure a Strong Future for our Community.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

On February 6, 2001 the Board of Supervisors approved a final (revised) 2000-2001 Budget for the Family Preservation and Support Program in Santa Barbara County, as proposed by the Department of Social Services, with the KIDS Network Policy Council as the FPSP steering committee and the KIDS Network Advisory Committee as the community advisory body. At that time, the Board requested that the Department return with an FPSP budget for the 2001-2002 fiscal year after the FPSP allocation amounts for that year were received from the State. In November 2001, the State advised us that our county's allocation for 2001-2002 would increase by approximately 5.6% to a total of \$370,063 (CFL 01/02-37).

In the attached Revised Budget the 5.6% increase in our county's allocation was added to all budget categories and contractors have been advised of the new amounts, pending Board approval.

Mandates and Service Levels:

No change

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

For the 2002 federal fiscal year (county fiscal year 2001-2002), Santa Barbara County will receive \$370,063 in Title IV-B federal FPSP allocation from the California Department of Social Services, representing an increase of approximately 5.6% over the prior year. Congress is currently in the process of approving the Federal Promoting Safe and Stable Families (PSSF) Amendments Act (HR 2873) for federal fiscal years 2002-2006, which would continue our county's FPSP funding for an additional four years. When further details are known, the Department will return to the Board with a proposed budget for 2002-2003.
