RESOLUTION HONORING CAROL PALLADINI THE SANTA BARBARA FOUNDATION 2013 WOMAN OF THE YEAR CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, Carol Palladini has been selected as the 2013 Woman of the Year by the Santa Barbara Foundation in recognition of the significant contributions she has made to the quality of life in our community; and

WHEREAS, Carol Palladini has devoted her time and energy to many local organizations and causes, focusing her efforts on helping nonprofit organizations become more prepared and strategic when making financial, and fundraising decisions; and

WHEREAS, Carol Palladini has volunteered her time and energy to create the Women's Fund of Santa Barbara using a simple creative model whereby women could combine their charitable donations for the benefit of women, children and families. Now in its tenth year, the Fund has awarded grants totaling \$4.7 million to 64 local nonprofit organizations impacting more than 83,000 local women. Fund membership has grown to nearly 600 women who contribute a minimum of \$2,500 every year; and

WHEREAS, Carol Palladini has provided leadership as Board President for Court Appointed Special Advocates to recruit and train local volunteers to advocate for the best interests of abused and neglected children. Carol worked successfully to increase contributions to the organization; and

WHEREAS, Carol Palladini has shared her expertise with Planned Parenthood of Santa Barbara where she served as a Board Member for six years and was named Volunteer of the Year. She participated in the planning and implementation of the annual fundraising dinner and later became a regular speaker at luncheons.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors honors Carol Palladini as the recipient of the 2013 Santa Barbara Foundation Woman of the Year Award and further commends her for a lifetime of outstanding leadership and dedicated service to our community.
