TEMPORARY ENTRY PERMIT

Permission is given to the County of Santa Barbara hereinafter referred to as County, and its officers, employees, agents and contractors, to enter, with all necessary equipment, upon property managed by the Administrative Office of the Courts, hereinafter referred to as AOC or Permittor, and described as: the Santa Maria Courts Complex, 312 East Cook Street, Santa Maria, CA

For the purpose of planned construction for seismic retrofit, and for such other incidental purposes as may be required, subject to the following provisions:

- 1. Reasonable precautions will be exercised to avoid damage and protect persons or property.
- 2. Permittor assumes no liability for loss or damage to property or injuries to or deaths of agents, contractors or employees of State by reason of the exercise of privileges given under this permit.
- 3. County agrees to indemnify and hold harmless AOC and the Superior Court of California and its officers, employees, agents from any damage caused by County's activities authorized by this permit. County agrees also to either reimburse Permittor for any damage or destruction to its roads and fences, or other property, occurring by reason of the exercise of rights granted, or to replace or restore said property to its pre-existing condition.
- 4. This agreement may be terminated at any time by the County or by the Permittor upon 30 days advance written notice.
- 5. Construction plans and schedule shall be shared with the Permittor at no cost.
- 6. All work shall be performed by County in a good and workmanlike manner and to the extent required by any applicable statute, law, regulation, governmental authority or court order.
- 7. All disruptive construction work shall be performed on nights, weekends or court holidays in order to permit the Superior Court of California, County of Santa Barbara to continue to hold court and continue with court business without disruption. Disruptive work is defined as work that disrupts or interferes with the operations of any portion of occupied areas within the Cook & Miller complex due to excessive noise or work traffic and includes the following work items:
 - a. Excessively noisy work on the <u>exterior</u> of buildings A, B and C to install shear wall assemblies, including plaster removal and sheathing installation.
 - b. Excessively noisy work on the <u>exterior</u> of Public Defender Addition and Buildings A and B needed to seismically separate them, including hammering and cutting.
 - c. All interior work within occupied areas of Public Defender office.
 - d. All interior work within Courtroom at Department 4, and Department 3.
 - e. All interior work within occupied areas of District Attorney Office.
 - f. All interior work within area currently occupied by Superior Court Employees.
- 8. Low noise generating work on the exterior of involved buildings and at unoccupied areas will be performed during normal operating hours. Any such noise deemed disruptive by the County's Project Manager or by his Point of Contacts to the AOC/Courts and County Departments shall be addressed immediately by the County Project Manager.
- 9. This permit expires upon completion of the seismic retrofit work.
